# **European Digital Learning Factory** (EDLF): Vision & Hybrid Model

#### **Objective**

#### Means and Instruments


- Vision: A pan-European hub for VET innovation, connecting labour market needs with digital education
- Model: Hybrid structure combining a Digital University, R&D Centre, and Smart Factory simulation
- Purpose: Driving green and digital transitions with industry-aligned, personalized learning

- ✓ Al-powered pathways for EQF levels 3–8
- ✓ ESCO-based skill gap detection (ESCO - European Skills, Competences, Qualifications and Occupations)
- ✓ Curricula co-created with employers & chambers
- ✓ Sector focus on Agriculture, Energy, Logistics, ICT
- ✓ Real-time tracking & feedback loops



# EDLF Impact: Inclusion, Innovation & Skills Ecosystem

*Impact* Features



- Mobility & Equity: Financial support for disadvantaged learners
- Innovation: Encouraging entrepreneurship to foster realworld digital solutions
- Skills Ecosystem: Sector-specific competencies in data, simulation, and automation



### **ASIIN's Role in the EDLF**

- Lead of WP7: External Quality Assurance Framework
- Expertise: >25 years in QA for HE & >15 years in VET
- Alignment with: EQF, EQAVET, ESG, DigCompEdu
- > Key deliverables:
  - QA framework for EDLF
  - Certification of programs, providers and EDLF as provider
  - Dissemination infrastructure





### The Three-Pillar QA Approach

#### 1. QA Framework


- Certification standards for short-cycle programs, providers, and EDLF
- Digital quality seal for programs

#### 2. Recognition Framework

- Align with ESG and EQAVET
- Ensure DEQAR-eligibility

#### 3. Dissemination Framework

Public visibility via ASIIN Academy, DEQAR, and a QA register hosted by EASPA





## **QA Framework Details**

- Unified QA standards (institutional + program level)
- Certification criteria aligned with EQAVET & ESG
- Pilot certifications to validate framework (programs, provider, EDLF)
- Certification of the EDLF itself as final step of the project





## Recognition Framework and EASPA as Skills Council

#### **Certification Scheme**

- Certification decisions by ASIIN Certification Commission
- Boosting credibility & recognition of EDLF microcredentials
- ➤ Listed in DEQAR (EQF 5+)



#### **EASPA** coming in:

- Hosting of cross-border, crossdisciplinary European Council for Digital and Sustainability Skills
- ASIIN (or other suitable QAAs) delivering certifications
- EASPA skills council/s to validate certifications
- Strategic alignment with subjectspecific QA networks



## Dissemination of EDLF-quality assured programs

#### **ASIIN Academy** could

- > Provide a scalable, online platform for certified programs
- Allow for an integration of EDLF offerings and search features
- Provide an interface for learners, providers, employers

#### **EASPA** could

- ➤ Host a register of certified EDLF programs and courses
- Contribute to global UNESCO/INQAAHE QA register (by 2027)





## **Summary & Strategic Impact**

#### **Key project results**

- > EASPA/ASIIN ensure QA backbone of the EDLF
- Certification, visibility, and trust through DEQAR, ASIIN Academy, and EASPA register
- Strengthens the role of micro-credentials in lifelong learning
- Contribute to EU policy goals, in particular on digital & green transitions
